A chair is a chair. But it can also be used as a clothes hanger or a stepladder. It is a favorite strategy of DIY culture to pry existing products away from their usual aims, as is the case with these lamps whose main element is a light reflector for professional photographers. You can find them in silver, gold, or white. For Ana Relvão and Gerhardt Kellermann, they formed the basis for a family of lamps. "It was important for us to keep everything as simple as possible; that's the only way you can ensure an idea stays open to other interpretations. A, B, C are our versions, but we'll be very happy if somebody tries a D,E, or F."
